

Hello, physics for healthcare professions, students. I can't believe our midterm exam is on **Wednesday, June 18 from 10 - 11:30 a.m. C.T.!** Please read the following instructions carefully before opening the exam.

1. The exam is closed-book and closed-note.
2. I will provide a list of equations for use on the exam.
3. You should begin preparing for the exam by looking over all of the solutions for all of the assignments you submitted during Weeks One and Two of this course. Note: All Week One solutions will be available after 11:30 a.m. C.T. on Tuesday, June 10, and all Week Two solutions will be available after 11:30 a.m. C.T. on Tuesday, June 17.
4. You may NOT work on the exam with any other student or any other person.
5. You have one chance in which to complete the exam. Make sure you complete and submit the exam before closing it.
6. You have **from 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, June 18 until 11:30 a.m. on Wednesday, June 18 in which to complete the exam.** That is only 1.5 hours. Prepare thoroughly before opening the exam!

7. You may use a calculator on the exam, but you are not allowed to use your cellphone at all. You may, however, use the calculator on your computer.
8. You may use scratch paper if you would like.
9. You will be able to access the exam by clicking the Blackboard "**Assignments**" button and then by clicking the "**Midterm Exam**" link.
10. The exam must be proctored. See page 3 of the course syllabus for proctoring information.
11. Your exam **proctor will provide you with the necessary password.**
