



Participation Points Behaviors List

Part of your grade for this course is based upon participation (see the syllabus on our Blackboard course page for grade details).

Regular class participation will help your grade, and your grade will suffer if you do not participate (or do not log your participation).

You can earn participation points for engaging in any of the following behaviors:

A. Asking Ms. Clanton a question. You can use our Blackboard discussion board or the Office Hours chat gadget in the Blackboard announcements page or in the online textbook to ask a question. In addition, you can ask a question by emailing Ms. Clanton.

B. Answering a question (correctly or incorrectly) that was asked by a classmate. You can use our Blackboard discussion board or the Office Hours chat gadget in the Blackboard announcements page or in the online textbook to answer a question.

C. Correctly correcting a mathematics- or science-related mistake made by Ms. Clanton (not those mistakes made by classmates).

Seated students must correct Ms. Clanton in class, but online students may correct Ms. Clanton by email or on the Blackboard discussion board.

D. Working out a problem—or otherwise writing—on the board in class.

E. Attending virtual office hours (on the Blackboard discussion board or in the Office Hours chat gadget).

F. Posting a message on the discussion board or to the Office Hours chat room.

G. Sending Ms. Clanton an email.

H. Participating in a study group consisting of at least yourself and one other person outside of class to work on physical science assignments or to prepare for a physical science test.

I. Working on physical science assignments or studying for a physical science exam with a tutor.

J. Making or appearing in a video of physical science-related material outside of class and submitting it via email to Ms. Clanton or filming others discussing or demonstrating physical science-related topics outside of class and submitting it to Ms. Clanton.
