1. The exam is proctored. See page three of the course syllabus for information about proctoring.
2. The exam is closed-book and closed-note.
3. I will provide a list of equations for use on the exam.
4. You should continue preparing for the exam by looking over all of the solutions for all of the assignments, *i.e.*, **the reading quizzes, homework assignments, lab activities, and Midterm Exam**, you submitted during Weeks One, Two, Three, and Four of this course. Note: All Week Four solutions will be available after 11:30 a.m. C.T. on Tuesday, July 1.
5. You may **NOT** work on the exam with any other student or any other person.
6. You have one chance in which to complete the exam. Make sure you complete and submit the exam before closing it.
7. You have **from 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, July 1 until 11:30 a.m. on Tuesday, July 1 in which to complete the exam.** That is only 1.5

hours. Prepare thoroughly before opening the exam!

8. You may use a calculator on the exam, but you are not allowed to use your cellphone at all. You may, however, use the calculator on your computer.
9. You may use scratch paper if you would like.
10. You will be able to access the exam by clicking the Blackboard "**Assignments**" button and then by clicking the "**Final Exam**" link.
11. **Your exam proctor will provide you with the necessary password.**
